TASTING NOTES:

Deep red in colour, the nose shows notes of black fruit and spice, with obvious floral nuances. Fresh and dried plums, excellent acidity and structure. Rich, silky tannins. Pleasant, long finish with notes of vanilla and chocolate.

VINIFICATION:

Alicante Bouschet is harvested as late as possible to obtain the rich and ripe fruit, powerful tannins that are characteristic of wines made from this grape variety in the Alentejo.

Prolonged maceration, followed by a 14-month ageing period in barrels, brought out all the richness of the grape variety.

FOOD PAIRING:

Lamb chops, veal, beef stew.
